Ongoing Sub- committee Activities / Charges & Strategies	 The Ethics Subcommittee is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life and wellbeing of patients and residents in the various post-acute and long-term care settings. We advocate for the PALTC community through collaborative efforts and educational initiatives and strive to ensure that ethical best practices are being considered. The sub-committee undertakes the following activities: Develop educational presentations for the Society that focus on ethical issues in PALTC. Enhance the Society's online educational materials with a focus on ethical topics in PALTC. Contribute articles that are ethics-based to Caring for the Ages and JAMDA. Interact with the larger organization to provide ethical feedback and insights when needed Be available for AMDA members to discuss or address ethical issues/concerns if they arise
Roles and	Chair
Responsibilities	Help structure agenda for meetings.
	 Run an effective meeting to ensure involvement of members and the advancement of activities and charges. Communication with the Board liaison before and after each Board meeting to share updates from the Sub-committee and to hear about new Board initiatives. Report back to the full Sub-committee on each discussion with the Board liaison. Identify, mentor, and groom the next Chair. Assist with structure and selection of members. Vice Chair Support the Chair to ensure responsibilities are met in a timely manner. Serve as interim Chair in the absence of the Chair. Recommend individuals to serve as the next Vice Chair. Ascend to the position of Chair.
	 Members Be prepared and actively participate in all conference calls and meetings. Work on projects as delegated by the Chair or Vice Chair.
Expected Commitment	The committee meets quarterly via conference call. Members are expected to review all agenda/materials prior to each meeting, attend the conference calls as scheduled.
	The estimated monthly time commitment is 1-5 hours.
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The Ethics Sub-committee is comprised of interested medical directors, physicians, and nurses, or Members of AMDA/PALTC who demonstrate an interest in ethics. This may include Medical Directors and physicians.
All sub-committee members serve a two (2) year term and are eligible for reappointment once. Terms run May to April. The Chair and Vice Chair each serve a two-year term and can be in addition to their previous 2 membership terms.
Members are appointed by the President with input from the Chair. The Committee Chair and/or Vice Chair is recommended by the outgoing Chair and appointed by the President.
 Express desire to serve with a special interest in ethical issues and best practices concerning the quality of care delivered to patients in post-acute and long-term care settings. Desire to advance the mission of AMDA. Ability to make the necessary time commitment. Must be a Society member in good standing. Must disclose all financial relationships on an annual basis. Ability to attend and actively participate in conference calls. Chair: In addition to the above requirements, when possible, the Chair should have previously served as the Vice Chair. Vice Chair: In addition to the above requirements, when possible, the Vice Chair should have previously served as a member.
