Ongoing Activities, Charges, and Strategies	 Ongoing committee activities include: Advising PALTmed on considerations related to equity and inclusion within our offerings (e.g., reviewing clinical practice guidelines for health equity considerations, etc.) Identifying barriers to inclusion and belonging within the organization and recommending actionable solutions Incorporating a continued focus on access to care, healthcare coverage, and ageism into our ongoing efforts as an organization, ensuring these factors are considered when developing new education, programs, and policies
Roles and Responsibilities	 Chair Help structure agenda for meetings. Run an effective meeting to ensure involvement of members and the advancement of activities and charges. Communication with the Board liaison before and after each Board meeting to share updates from the committee and to hear about new Board initiatives. Report back to the full committee on each discussion with the Board liaison. Identify, mentor, and groom the next Chair. Assist with structure and selection of members.
	 Vice Chair Support the Chair to ensure responsibilities are met in a timely manner. Serve as interim Chair in the absence of the Chair. Recommend individuals to serve as the next Vice Chair. Ascend to the position of Chair. Members Be prepared and actively participate in all conference calls and meetings. Work on projects as delogated by the Chair.
